AUDITION for all positions will take place at the Finnish National Opera on Monday 12.5.2025.

Required pieces:

- 1) Mozart: Violin Concerto no. 3 in G major or no. 4 in D major or no. 5 in A major; 1st movement without cadenza
- 2) 1st movement from a major romantic concerto
- 3) Chamber music excerpt Schubert: String Quintet D. 956 (1. movement)
- 4) Orchestral excerpts

Music for the chamber music and orchestral excerpts will be sent after the application has been submitted.

An accompanist will be provided but candidates may bring their own pianist if they so desire.

The candidates selected for the audition will be informed after the closing date.

Application for the positions should be submitted by 21.4.2025.

Position is open to applicants of any nationality.


