We are looking for a dedicated orchestral musician who would like to invest in the Oslo Philharmonic and thereby make a significant contribution to the rich cultural life of the city of Oslo.

The co-principal cello performs in both the first and second chairs, together with the principal cello, sharing responsibilities on the podium.

The successful candidate needs to be a strong and experienced leader, and also a team player. They will be expected to be based in Oslo.

The co-principal cello position includes the offer to play on a magnificent Grancino cello on loan from the orchestra's collection. The position requires 34 performing weeks per season. The salary is (depending on seniority) NOK 714 047-771 580 (for 2022-23).
