### Required material for audition:

- **1st round:** Mozart: *Violin Concerto no. 4 in D major, K. 218*, 1st movement with cadenza & 2nd movement or Mozart: *Violin Concerto no. 5 in A major, K. 219*, 1st movement with cadenza & 2nd movement + orchestral excerpts
- **2nd round:** 1st movement of one of the following concertos with cadenza: Beethoven, Brahms, Tchaikovsky, Sibelius, or Nielsen + orchestral excerpts
- **3rd round:** Orchestral excerpts with orchestra

All music to be played in orchestral tuning A = 442 hz

Orchestral excerpts will be sent electronically to the applicants after the closing date for applications and will be available to download on our website **April 12th at the latest**.

The audition will take place at the Symphonic Hall at Musikhuset Aarhus (Concert Hall Aarhus), Skovgaardsgade 2C, 8000 Aarhus C, Denmark. The Aarhus Symphony Orchestra will provide a pianist on the day of the audition but travelling expenses and expenses for accommodation must be met by the applicant.

**SALARY:** Salary pursuant to the current agreements between the musicians' union and the Danish regional symphony orchestras.
